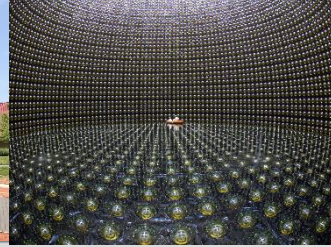


STUDY ABROAD JAPAN

- ❑ MA 399 (H. Tsutsui): **Origamics** -- *Geometry of Paper Folding* --
This class can be approved for the math minor credits, as well as any math electives and gen ed math. Field Trips include: Japan Origami Museum, Himeji Castle, and Kyoto Kimono and Origami experience.
- ❑ SP 160 (M. Zanolin): **Physics II**
The course deals with waves and thermodynamics. Field Trips include: Kobe Earthquake Museum, Tsunami and Storm Surge Disaster Prevention Station, and Super-Kamiokande.
- ❑ RS 299: **Introduction to Japanese history, culture and society**
