Transfer from airport to the Sacred Valley	Rest and acclimatizing <b>Visit Ollantaytambo fortress and inca town</b> <i>Night in Hostal Tambo in Ollantaytambo</i>	Our staff will be waiting for you at the airport in Cusco. You will be taken to Ollantaytambo in the Sacred Valley for orientation. Ollantaytambo is an Inca fortress and perhaps the only Inca town continuously inhabited for 500 years. <b>(L,D)</b>
<b>Friday May 11</b>	<b>Hike to the Ollantaytambo quarries</b>	<i>Night in Hostal Tambo in Ollantaytambo</i>	The Inca fortress was built with stones coming from across the valley. We will hike a gentle slope to see some of the stones that remained in place, and enjoy Ollantaytambo from above. <b>(B,L,D)</b>
<b>Saturday May 12</b>	<b>8:00 a.m. travel to Písaq from Ollantaytambo</b> <b>Visit Písaq</b>	<b>Lunch in Písaq</b> <b>Return to Cusco</b> <i>Night in homestay in Cusco</i>	<b>Písaq</b> , the beauty of its walls, built with big blocks of polished stones of extraordinary symmetry and incomparable work of masonry are a marvelous sample of Inca architecture. The town also has an interesting craft market and if you are lucky you might even witness traditional bartering of goods between peasants on the market square.  At 11,150 ft., <b>Cusco</b> is one of the highest cities in the world. Make sure you get plenty of rest on your first full day in Cusco and drink lots of liquids. <b>(B,L,D)</b>

Its colorful market is a gathering for small farmers and weavers who trade their products. <b>Chinchero</b> is also one of the most important center of traditional textile production, and this since Inca times. We will visit Loraypo, an association of weavers set up with support from Kuraka, the NGO partnered with Centro Tinku. The salt pans of <b>Maras</b> were first used in pre-inca times and are now exploited by a cooperative of indigenous inhabitants. <b>Moray</b> is a group of circular terraces, believed to have been an Inca experimental agricultural station. <b>(B,L,D)</b></p>

In the century since its discovery many hypotheses have been put forward about the nature of Machu Picchu, the reason for its construction and its sudden desertion.
