Speaker: Professor Murray Henner

Professor Henner has taught Constitutional Law at Hofstra University School of Law, The Arizona State University College of Law, The Phoenix School of Law, the University of Pittsburgh School of Law and at several foreign Law Schools including those in Berlin, Leipzig and Antwerp. He is a Full Professor at ERAU’s College of Security and Intelligence and is entering into almost two decades of teaching and mentoring students in U.S. Government, International Law, Jurisprudence, Intelligence Ethics and Global Criminal Justice. He holds a Post-Doctoral (L.L.M Degree) in International Law and a Juris Doctor Degree from Hofstra University.

Professor Henner is an active member of several Federal Courts, State Superior Courts, and served as a Naval Judge Advocate for over 22 years. He is also a member of the N.Y., Pennsylvania, Texas, D.C., Arizona, California and Alabama Bars. He is the author of over 40 peer journal law review and related publications as well as several books. He has also served as a Judge and Magistrate in several state and federal courts.

Professor Henner has also been an advisor to key intelligence and political leaders as same regards US-Israel and US-Germany foreign policy and relations. He is fluent in several languages including German, Hebrew and Flemish.
