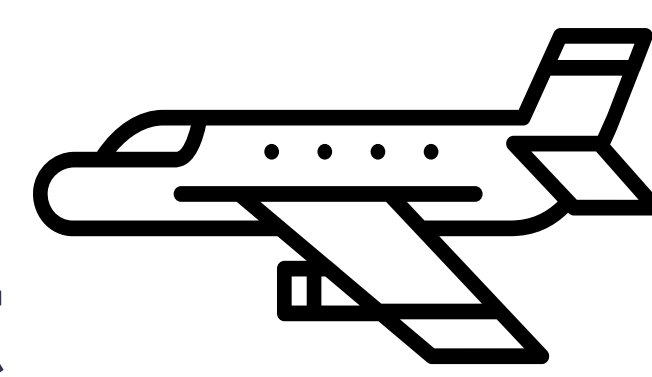

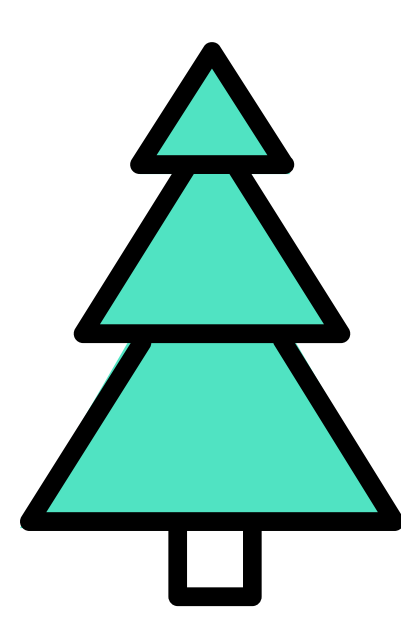

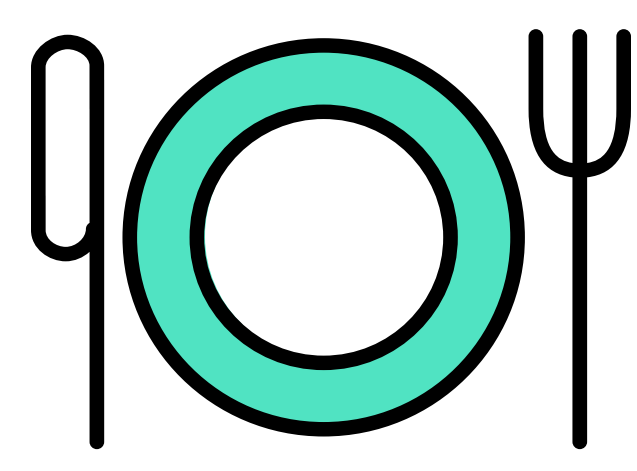
Note that while classes end before the Thanksgiving holiday, the residence halls DO NOT close

01

Pack up and take all the things you'll need for break

02

Unplug electronics and other personal items
DO NOT unplug ERAU appliances & fish tanks

03

Take out trash and perishable items to the dumpster
Check your fridge for food to throw out!

04

Set heat to low

05

Turn off lights & close/lock your window & door
Staff will be entering rooms over break to ensure tasks were completed by residents

Returning to your room in Spring 2021

If you're not returning to Housing in the Spring you have a few things to do

01

Complete a Break Housing Request at prhousing.erau.edu
-Graduating seniors don't need to complete a request
-Request MUST be approved to be released from contract
-Click Here

02

If you are not returning to ERAU, you need to fill out a withdrawal form

After your request is approved:

03

Pack up and take ALL of your belongings
Do not leave items

04

Do your fair share of cleaning & take all trash to dumpster
Check your fridge to throw out food!

05

Set heat to low

Staff will be entering rooms over break to ensure tasks were completed by residents

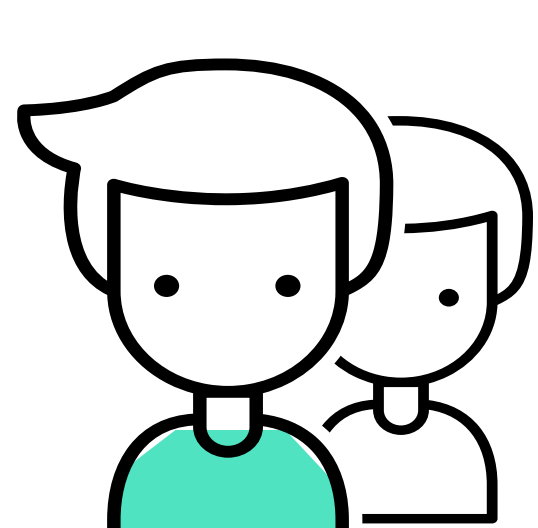
07

NOT Returning to your room in Spring 2021

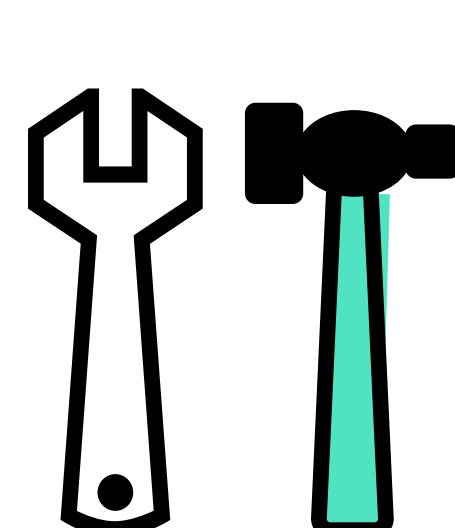
Must be moved out by Sunday, December 13th at noon

Other things to keep in mind



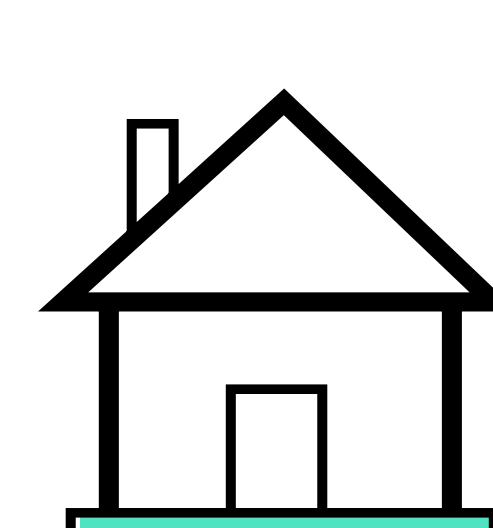
No roommate?
