## Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University – Prescott Campus Student Right-to-Know Act Graduation Rate Report

In accordance with the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended, Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University - Prescott Campus is pleased to share with you the following information on the graduation rates of our most recent cohorts of full-time, first-time, degree or certificate seeking undergraduates and student athletes that received athletic financial aid.

While reviewing this information, please keep the following in mind:

- All graduation rates are based upon 6 years of attendance which equates to 150% of the normal completion time of our longest program.
- We have elected not to report transfer-out rates because our university's mission does not include providing substantial preparation for students to enroll in another eligible institution without completing or graduating.
- These charts do not identify the reasons why our students withdrew; therefore, students who withdrew for personal or medical reasons are included.
- Graduation rates do not include students who left school to serve in the armed forces or on official church missions or with a foreign aid service of the federal government, or students who died or were totally and permanently disabled.
- A pound sign (#) denotes any cohort/subcohort with five or fewer students. The university is not required to disclose this information.
- Breakouts by sport are grouped as follows: Basketball, Baseball, Cross-country/Track, and All Other Sports. All of Prescott's sports currently fall into the All Other Sports category.
